DES Report:

- Paging - Still working on CAD interface, RMI is displaying paging accessories at the Assoc. Meeting.

- Homeland Security Grants - No funding for the current grant cycle. Still working through a court proceeding on the 2025 funding.

- New Hazmat truck should be in service by the end of April.
